Year 12	<p>Sociology is the study of humans and society looking at what has formed the contemporary societies we live in today and what are the pros and cons of how we have developed our societies. In Sociology students study one compulsory and one optional topic each year</p> <p>In year 12 students study the compulsory topic of Sociology of Education and the optional area of Family and Households. Sociology of Education also includes a review of Sociological theories and methods.</p>
Year 13	<p>In Year 13 students study the compulsory topic of Crime and Deviance and the optional topic of Beliefs in Society. Crime and Deviance also includes a review of Sociological theories and methods.</p> <p>The course is examined through 3 exam papers taken at the end of Year 13.
