

PUBLIC EXAMINATION RESULTS - SUMMER 2018 GCSE RESULTS

Outstanding individual results included;

28 out of 138 pupils gaining 4 or more "top" grades 9-7 (Formerly A* & A) In addition three students also completed an **EPQ3 qualification**, usually a sixth form qualification, **achieving grades B,C & D.**

Overall **19 grade 9s** were awarded.

"First entry" % **9-4 (formerly A*-C)** in: Maths was **64%**, English Literature **69%**, English Language **73%** .

In Triple Science **100%** of students achieved **9-4** in Chemistry and grades **9-5** in both Biology and in Physics.

67% of students achieved a grade **9-4** in science and **80%** of students achieved at least one grade 4 in combined science.

Outstanding subject results included;

33% of all Chemistry students achieved an **8 or 9**

52% of all Physics students achieved an **8 or 9**

92% **9-5** in Music

82% **9-5** in Art

80% **A-C** in DT

75% **9-4** in German

83% **Merit - Distinction*** in BTEC Dance

The students' hard work and commitment to their learning is evident in these excellent exam results. These results reflect the outstanding curriculum provision on offer at The Priory and are a testament to the excellent relationships between students and their teachers.
