

The Priory School A level examination results 2018.

Priory6 (The Priory School's sixth form provision) is a fully inclusive sixth form which encourages all students to access Level 3 courses (A level and A level equivalent) and consists of students with a variety of academic backgrounds. We have students of the highest academic ability as well as having the flexibility to inspire others who may not be permitted to study to this level at other institutions.

Students from Priory6 achieved a range of excellent results in the Summer A level and Level 3 BTEC examinations. Teachers and students have worked extremely hard to gain an impressive set of outcomes with many students sitting newly reformed A level syllabuses with an increased emphasis on terminal examinations.

In a cohort of 41 students some particularly outstanding results were Elliot who secured A*, A, A in Business Studies, Maths and Physics as well as Head Girl Abbie who achieved an A and a B in her A levels and a double Distinction* in her BTEC course. (A* and Distinction* are the highest achievable grades.) In addition, many students achieved or exceeded their nationally comparable target grades.

Business Studies (A level and BTEC), History, Dance, Sociology, Law, ICT, Further Maths, PE, Design and Technology, English Literature, Health & Social Care, History, Chemistry, Geography, Media Studies, Politics, Philosophy and Ethics and Spanish all achieved a 100% pass rate. A small cohort of students entered the Level 3 Extended Project Qualification which allows them to research and prepare a report independently in an area of their choice leading to a range of results including A and B grades.

Each year, students from Priory6 go on to study at many different universities including many Russell Group institutions (those that are considered outstanding due to their research and course delivery). This year has been no exception with students going on to study courses such as Mechanical and Civil Engineering, Cyber Security, Creative Writing, Architecture, Politics with International Relations and Paramedical Science (amongst many other courses) at universities that include Loughborough, Coventry, St Georges University of London and Birmingham. All Priory6 students who wanted to go to university have secured a place to study. In addition we have students who have gone on to study a range of apprenticeships. This includes the growing area of Higher Level apprenticeships where they can gain a degree level qualification in subjects such as Business Studies alongside getting vital experience working in the industry and making future employment connections, often without accruing the debt often associated with going to university.
