

Public Examinations Results Summer 2017

GCSE results – headline figures

74% of students achieved grades 9-4 in English and 58% achieved grades 9-5 in English.

66% of students achieved grades 9-4 in Maths and 56% achieved 9-5 in Maths.

Overall, 56% of students achieved 9-4 in both English and Maths, with 38% achieving grades 9-5 in both.

The Priory School's validated P8 score is -0.02 which is in line with the national average and above the floor standard.

The school's Attainment 8 score is 43.6, again in line with the national average.

35% of our students achieved the English Baccalaureate at grade 5/C or above.

96% of our students stayed in education or entered employment at the end of Key Stage 4.

Areas of excellence:

GCSE Biology = 100% A*-C with 38% A*/A

GCSE Chemistry = 100% with 34% A*/A

GCSE Physics = 100% A*-C with 52% A*/A

GCSE D&T = 82% A*-C, with 37% A*/A
