

STUDENT UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

This is to clarify what is acceptable and not acceptable with regards to uniform, hair, make-up and jewellery. If a student is not in full school uniform alternative clothing will be provided, OR students will be put into isolation OR sent home to change. We expect parents to support the school on all issues regarding uniform.

Smart watches linked to mobile devices will be confiscated if used for communication purposes. Priory6 Dress Code

Priory6 students are expected to be dressed appropriately for a work environment. Although we rarely have issues with Priory6 dress there are occasions where students may need to be reminded of the following guidelines (generally during spells of hot weather):

- *All skirts/shorts should be of a reasonable length.*
- *Vest tops should have straps that reach the top of the shoulder and should not have string or spaghetti straps.*
- *All tops should be long enough to meet trousers or skirts/shorts - no exposed midriff.*
- *Tops should not have low cut necklines that expose excessive cleavage/chest.*
- *Dresses/playsuits should meet the guidelines above.*

Staff are requested in the first instance to speak to students who they believe have contravened these guidelines and ask them to cover up if necessary such as donning a jumper or cardigan. Staff should also notify PHA who will follow up if necessary and contact home for repeat offenders.

Appearance

Make up: The only make up that is permitted in school is a small amount of neutral coloured foundation.

Hair: Extremes of haircut and dyed hair are not permitted at school. Boys and girls need to bear this in mind when having their hair cut.

Blazers: Should be worn at all times inside the school buildings, unless staff allow them to be taken off in lessons, and on your way home from school. Blazers need not be worn when outside in the school grounds at break or lunch times.

Shirts and Blouses must be tucked in at all times.

Stationery

Students need to come to school everyday with a fully equipped pencil case containing the following:

- 2 Black pens
- 2 Pencils
- 1 Ruler (cm/mm)
- Rubber
- Pair of compasses
- Protractor
- Scientific calculator
