TOP TIP

Think about what you want the message of your poem to be. Remember what it is as you write, and when your poem is finished check if your message is clear to the reader.

POETRY TECHNIQUES

Remember, a poem doesn't have to rhyme! Here are some other techniques you can use:

- Alliteration a series of words that begin with the same sound
- **h** Enjambment continuing a sentence onto a new line for flow or emphasis
- Nimile compares two different things using the words "like" or "as"
- Rhetorical questions a question that you don't expect to be answered, used to guide the reader or make them consider
- Numbolism using a colour or object to represent something else like an emotion or tone
- 🔥 Repetition using the same word or phrase more than once
