KS3 Enrichment / Homework update following feedback

Following the feedback received regarding recent changes to our enrichment/homework program, we have adapted our provision. Please see below the changes; students will be informed of these on the first day back in January so a clear message is sent out.

Enrichment Work

- Subjects will provide optional enrichment activities each half term
- Students in Year 9 should consider doing enrichment tasks in the subject areas that they intend to take at GCSE level
- Students will receive house points for well completed enrichment work
- Students will not be sanctioned for not completing enrichment work
- The enrichment tasks for all subjects will be published in the first week of each new half term
- They will be put on Edulink in one document called 'Enrichment'.
- PE, Drama, Food, MFL and Geography tasks will be due in the first part of each half term (date will be specified with the task)
- Music, DT, Art History, Computing and RE tasks will be due in the second part of each half term (date will be specified with the task)

Compulsory Homework

- Maths is a compulsory 1 hour every week on Sparx set on EduLink. A 30 minute lunchtime detention will be set if this is not completed.
- English is a compulsory 30 minutes every week A set on EduLink. A 30 minute lunchtime detention will be set if this is not completed.
- Science is a compulsory 30 minutes every week B set on EduLink. A 30 minute lunchtime detention will be set if this is not completed.
