Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware we had one of our INSET days last Monday, as always it was extremely busy for all our staff. This particular session was based on how we as a school ensure that we "intentionally welcome everyone into our community." To ensure this happens, all our staff have now been trained to carry our restorative practice every day. Ensuring that all students are aware of our expectations and do their best to meet them; staff will be going above and beyond to ensure that students are spoken and listened to, helping establish the big picture for each day.

I recently sent out a questionnaire regarding parental opinion of whether students should continue to wear school ties. This is not because we want to relax our expectations of our students but to acknowledge that society has changed significantly over the years and with regards to students moving on to work after education there are fewer professionals that now wear such professional attire including ties. There are also more students with sensory issues and a shirt done up around the neck causes significant distress for them on a daily basis. We are also aware that many parents/carers end up having to purchase a number of ties throughout the year due to their child losing ties or breaking them; this causes financial implications for some. The results from parents/carers have been very mixed with many in support of losing ties from the compulsory part of the uniform and others raising concerns that the standards will lower if this became the case. I am obviously not taking this decision lightly and will this week be exploring the opinions of our students before a final decision is made.
