

Increase in 'Sextortion': financially motivated sexual extortion

Following the tragic case in Scotland of a young boy who died by suicide after being tricked online in to sending compromising pictures, the National Crime Agency (NCA) has contacted all schools and asked them to share advice with parents. You can read the full letter <u>here</u> and we have summarised the advice below.

- Organised crime gangs are targeting young people online, posing as teenagers and encouraging young people to exchange nude pictures online often using platforms such as Snapchat, Whatsapp or a range of chat rooms
- They then demand payment or threaten to share the pictures online
- Cases have increased by 150% between 2022 and 2023 with more than 22'000 cases last year The NCA has advised parents to:
- Talk to their children about the dangers of sharing nude or semi-nude pictures online
- Talk to them about the fact that unless they know someone in real life, they may not be who they appear to be online
- Reassure them that if this happens, they are not to blame and they must report it to a trusted adult
- Familiarise themselves with the variety of online places to report such crimes Parents are also advised that if their child becomes a victim of 'sextortion':
- Reassure them that they are not to blame
- Block the messages and contact but do not delete any messages as they may be needed as evidence
- Not to pay; there is no guarantee that a payment will stop the demands for more money or prevent the sharing of images
- Use online tools such as 'Report Remove' or 'Take it Down' to get the images removed
