Dear parents, carers and students

I am writing to you all in preparation for students who will either be returning to school or starting in September.

Uniform expectations

In July I wrote to outline some changes which we have introduced to our school uniform. As a reminder.

Students must wear at least one, two, or all three of the following items:

- School tie (Not house tie) Optional
- School jumper with the school logo Optional (available from the Kit Shop)
- School blazer with the school logo Optional (available from the Kit Shop)
- The school jumper/blazer are the only one's students will be permitted to wear in school. No other jumper or casual jacket will be allowed.

False nails, fake eyelashes and nail polish continue to be prohibited so please ensure that you arrive on the first day without these.

It is also imperative that unless you have a medical note, you must be wearing black **leather (leather lookalike)**, polishable shoes.

The school has purchased numerous new pairs of shoes in all sizes, ready for any student that may arrive at school with incorrect footwear. These will be available until your child is in the correct uniform.
