


## A Parent's Guide to STAR Reading

### ***What is a STAR Reading Test?***

The STAR reading test is a computer-based reading assessment program that uses computer-adaptive technology that we use to monitor students independent reading practice. Questions continually adjust to the student's response. The test uses multiple-choice questions and takes approximately 20 minutes. Students will take the STAR test at least once a term in their Study Centre lesson to assess their progress in reading.

### ***Teachers, LSA's and the Librarian may assist students by:***

- Guiding them to books appropriate to their ability and interests
- Asking probing questions as the student reads and before quizzing.
- Reading with or reading to the student.



### ***How can I help my child become a better reader?***

- Be interested in what students are reading
- Ensure Students read regularly.
- Know your child's book level- teachers will inform students in lessons and parents via progress reports
- Direct students to the Study Centre tab on school website to select books.
