GCSE Results 2025

Key GCSE Achievements:

- Attainment 8 score: 44.3, reflecting strong overall performance across eight key qualifications.
- English: 70% of students achieved a grade 4 or above.
- Mathematics: 67% of students secured a grade 4 or above.
- Sciences: In Biology, Chemistry, and Physics, an impressive 100% of students achieved a grade 4 or above, demonstrating excellence in the sciences.
- Additionally, 60% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in Combined Science.
- Our students achieved 28 grade 9s across 12 different subjects, showcasing aspirational academic success.

Note: Progress 8 data is not available for the 2025 GCSE cohort. This is a national decision that affects all schools.

Progress 8 normally measures the progress pupils make from primary school (Key Stage 2) to their GCSEs. However, this cohort did not sit the Key Stage 2 SATs in 2020 or 2021 because these assessments were cancelled during the COVID-19 pandemic. Without this KS2 data, the Department for Education cannot calculate Progress 8 for this year group.
