Key Achievements

- Attainment 8 score of 40.27; reflecting good overall performance across 8 subjects
- 75% grade 4 to 9 in English Literature **above** the national average of 73.6%, demonstrating a rapid improvement in attainment
- 100% grade 4 to 9 in Biology, Chemistry and Physics, maintaining our outcomes **above** the national averages in triple science again this year.

Note: Progress 8 data is not available for the 2025 GCSE cohort. This is a national decision that affects all schools. Progress 8 normally measures the progress pupils make from primary school (Key Stage 2) to their GCSEs. However, this cohort did not sit the Key Stage 2 SATs in 2020 or 2021 because these assessments were cancelled during the COVID-19 pandemic. Without this KS2 data, the Department for Education cannot calculate Progress 8 for this year group
